Today, as President and CEO, he leads First Class Real Estate, LLC-the largest Haitian-owned real estate firm in Florida, boasting over 100 agents. The company now operates three offices serving distinct regions: Miami-Dade & Monroe Counties; Palm Beach & Broward Counties; and Central Florida including Orlando, Tampa, and Port Sainte Lucie. Jean Marc's goal is to grow the firm to 500 real estate agents.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Beyond his business ventures, Jean Marc is a fervent advocate for community development. In 2016, he founded the Organisation Professionnelle pour le Développement Éducatif de Bainet (OPDEB), establishing the first technical school in Bainet, Haiti. The institution offers courses in construction, tailoring, bakery, plumbing, electricity, computer technology, mechanics, and basic English, empowering over 500 students with vocational skills. His five-year vision is to see OPDEB own a dedicated building in Bainet, Haiti, that will serve as a permanent home for an orphanage capable of accommodating up to 1,000 children. In addition, he plans to expand the existing technical school to serve the neighboring regions of Lavalee-De-Jacmel, Côte-de-Fer, and Gris-Gris; empowering more youth with access to education, skills training, and opportunity.
